

Grid – “Completing mobile forms has never been faster.”

Meet grid: the fastest way to capture information on a mobile device. Canvas has upped the ante by creating a user interface that guarantees rapid data collection.

The List (Simple) layout is a screen layout that will allow the user to enter a list of responses for a single field. In addition, you can optionally capture additional fields for each response in the list. The additional fields will be displayed in a single Labels Above layout following the list screen. If you have a list where you want to capture details on multiple screens or use another screen layout for the additional screen use the List (Advanced) screen layout.
